7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award of a Justice Assistance Grant Victim Advocacy Grant from the Ohio**
9 **Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of**
10 **\$20,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement in the amount of \$6,666.67, and a**
11 **supplemental cash match amount of \$12,652.67 required for certain employment**
12 **expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, and**
13 **appropriating the amount of \$39,319.34, which includes the total local cash match**
14 **requirement, for calendar year 2014, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, has
17 awarded a Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) Victim Advocacy Grant of federal funds, in the
18 amount of \$20,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement, in the amount of \$6,666.67, for
19 the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14; and

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21 WHEREAS, an additional local cash match of \$12,652.67, for a total match of
22 \$19,319.34, is needed to cover the program’s additional personnel costs, including that of the
23 employee’s hospital waiver and life insurance as these items are not covered under the grant
24 guidelines; and

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26 WHEREAS, the match funds are appropriated in the Prosecutor’s 2014 operating budget,
27 identified in Resolution No. 2013-493; and

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29 WHEREAS, this annual funding supports a victim advocate position in order to provide
30 the mandated services to victims of crime; and

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32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
33 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
34 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio
35 Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
38 of Ohio, that:

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42 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
43 the Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) award from the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of
44 Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of \$20,000.00, with a 25% local cash match
45 requirement in the amount of \$6,666.67, and a supplemental cash match amount of \$12,652.67,
46 required for additional personnel costs including certain employment expenditures not covered
47 by the grant, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, for a total amount of \$39,319.34.
