7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to conduct an auction, through Skipco**
8 **Auto Auction, of various surplus Sheriff's Office vehicles, per attached Exhibit A, with a**
9 **total fair market value exceeding \$15,000.00, for a cost to the County of an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$5,000.00, and authorizing the Executive to execute any documents with Skipco**
11 **Auto Auction necessary to conduct said auction, for the Executive, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has various surplus vehicles per attached Exhibit A; and

16 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office wishes to auction said vehicles, which have a total fair
17 market value exceeding \$15,000.00, which requires the approval of County Council pursuant to
18 Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

20 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office intends to conduct said auction through Skipco Auto
21 Auction at a cost to the County of \$125.00 per vehicle for the auction and \$55.00 per vehicle for
22 pickup, for a total cost to the County of an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00; and

24 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute any documents with
25 Skipco Auto Auction necessary to conduct said auction; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Sheriff's
29 Office to conduct an auction, through Skipco Auto Auction, of various surplus Sheriff's Office
30 vehicles, per attached Exhibit A, with a total fair market value exceeding \$15,000.00, for a cost
31 to the County of an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, and to authorize the Executive to execute
32 any documents with Skipco Auto Auction necessary to conduct said auction;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The Summit County Sheriff's Office hereby authorized to conduct an auction, through
40 Skipco Auto Auction, of various surplus Sheriff's Office vehicles, per attached Exhibit A,
41 attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, with a total fair market value
42 exceeding \$15,000.00. The cost to the County shall not exceed the amount of \$125.00 per
43 vehicle for the auction and \$55.00 per vehicle for pick-up, for a total cost to the County of an
44 amount not to exceed \$5,000.00. The Executive is further authorized to execute any documents
45 with Skipco Auto Auction necessary to conduct said auction.

49 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
50 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for further purpose of immediately
51 authorizing the Sheriff's Office to conduct an auction of various surplus County vehicles, per
52 attached Exhibit A, through Skipco Auto Auction.
