7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract renewal (first of five) with The Young Men's Christian Association of Akron, Inc.,**  
9 **dba Akron Area YMCA, for drop-in child care services at the OhioMeansJobs facility, fka**  
10 **The Job Center, for all regardless of income, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, in an**  
11 **amount not to exceed \$67,346.58, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**  
12 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 7, 2014, awarded a  
15 professional service contract renewal (first of five) with The Young Men's Christian Association  
16 of Akron, Inc., dba Akron Area YMCA, for drop-in child care services at the OhioMeansJobs  
17 facility, fka The Job Center, for all regardless of income, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15,  
18 subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
21 that the contract renewal is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract renewal (first of  
29 five) with The Young Men's Christian Association of Akron, Inc., dba Akron Area YMCA, for  
30 drop-in child care services at the OhioMeansJobs facility, fka The Job Center, for all regardless  
31 of income, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, in an amount not to exceed \$67,346.58, is  
32 hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract  
33 renewal.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
39 provide for drop-in child care services effective 7/1/14.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


