7 **A Resolution, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, authorizing the Executive to**
8 **execute a professional service contract for an employment services agreement with United**
9 **Labor Agency, for employment services for adults, dislocated workers and displaced**
10 **homemakers, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, with two one-year renewal options, in**
11 **an amount not to exceed \$963,318.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
12 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services desires to award a
15 professional service agreement for an employment services agreement with United Labor
16 Agency, for employment services for adults, dislocated workers and displaced homemakers, for
17 the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, with two one-year renewal options; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the
21 Executive to execute said contract subject to the approval of the Board of Control;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The Executive is hereby authorized, subject to approval by the Board of Control, to
29 execute a professional service contract for an employment services agreement with United Labor
30 Agency, for employment services for adults, dislocated workers and displaced homemakers, for
31 the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, with two one-year renewal options, in an amount not to
32 exceed \$963,318.00.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide for the employment services agreement effective 7/1/14.

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


