7 **A Resolution declaring Thursday, July 24, 2014, as Community Safety Day and**
8 **encouraging the residents of Summit County to participate in the program offered by the**
9 **Sheriff that is designed to raise awareness of the County's public safety forces, for the**
10 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Sheriff will be holding a Community Safety Day at the Summit County
13 Fairgrounds on Thursday, July 24, 2014, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; and

15 WHEREAS, this event will have many of the County's safety equipment and services on
16 display, such as the K-9 units, County Bomb Squad, helicopters from Metro Health and
17 Children's Hospital, vehicles and safety booths in order to promote awareness to the public about
18 the safety forces of the County; and

20 WHEREAS, the goal of this day is to foster public awareness of the various public safety
21 forces in the County in a family-friendly environment that would harvest a positive relationship
22 between the residents and safety forces in Summit County; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare Thursday, July 24,
26 2014, as Community Safety Day;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
29 State of Ohio, that:

33 The Summit County Council hereby declares Thursday, July 24, 2014, as Community
34 Safety Day and encourages all the residents of the County to participate in the program offered
35 by the Sheriff that is designed to raise awareness of the County's public safety forces.

39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
41 declaring support of Community Safety Day in Summit County prior to the commencement of
42 said day.

46 The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to distribute this Resolution to all political sub-
47 divisions within the County of Summit.
