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8 **An Ordinance approving and adopting the 2014 replacement pages for the Codified**
9 **Ordinances of the County of Summit, for County Council, and declaring an emergency.**
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11 WHEREAS, the County has entered into a contract with Walter H. Drane Company to
12 prepare and publish an updating of the ordinances of the County of Summit; and
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14 WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to
15 conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and
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17 WHEREAS, the updating of the related laws, ordinances, and resolutions, together with
18 the proper numbering or renumbering thereof has been prepared, completed, and is now before
19 this Council; now
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21 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of
22 Ohio, that:
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24 SECTION 1
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26 The Ordinances and Resolutions of the County of Summit, Ohio, enacted between May
27 13, 2013 and April 1, 2014, all of which have been previously enacted and adopted by the
28 County Council, are hereby approved as numbered or renumbered and printed in the 2014
29 Replacement Pages as prepared by the Walter H. Drane Company, of Cleveland, Ohio.
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31 SECTION 2
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33 The sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes as listed in Appendix A and
34 attached as Exhibit A - of this ordinance are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively
35 indicated in order to comply with current State law.
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37 SECTION 3
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39 The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to distribute the 2014 Replacement Pages to
40 those individuals possessing Codification Books and to instruct those individuals responsible for
41 updating the books to do so in an efficient and timely manner.
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5 SECTION 4

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7 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency to provide an additional means of
8 exercise of powers and administration over local matters for the County of Summit in the interest
9 of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit.

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11 SECTION 5


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13 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take

23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


