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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the Summit County
16 Children Services pavement improvement project, in Council District 2, for an estimated total
17 cost not to exceed \$56,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, a copy of the plans and specifications are attached as Exhibit A; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that is necessary and in the best interest of the Summit County to authorize the Executive to
23 advertise for bids for the Summit County Children Services pavement improvement project, in
24 Council District 2;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Summit County, State of
27 Ohio, that;

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29 SECTION 1

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31 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the Summit County Children
32 Services pavement improvement project, in Council District 2, for an estimated total cost not to
33 exceed \$56,000.00.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
38 of the citizens of the Summit County, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive
39 to immediately advertise for bids for the Summit County Children Services pavement
40 improvement project in Council District 2.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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
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SECTION 4
