7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental**  
8 **agreement with the County of Summit Fiscal Office for a IV-D contract to accept cash**  
9 **payments from child support clients, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, in an amount**  
10 **not to exceed \$140,407.42, for the Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency, and**  
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 6, 2014, awarded an  
14 intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit Fiscal Office for a IV-D contract to  
15 accept cash payments from child support clients, for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, subject to  
16 confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the County  
27 of Summit Fiscal Office for a IV-D contract to accept cash payments from child support clients,  
28 for the period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, in an amount not to exceed \$140,407.42, is hereby  
29 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

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31 SECTION 2

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
35 provide for the acceptance of cash payments from child support clients effective 7/1/14.

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37 SECTION 3

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39 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
40 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
41 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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45 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
