7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an award of an Impaired Driving Enforcement Program grant from the Ohio**  
9 **Department of Public Safety, for the period 10/1/14 to 9/30/15, in the amount of \$49,719.55,**  
10 **with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating grant funds, for the period**  
11 **10/1/14 through 12/31/14, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, County of Summit Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant in the amount  
14 of \$49,719.55, with no local cash match requirement, from Ohio Department of Public Safety  
15 ("ODPS"), through their Ohio Traffic Safety Office ("OTSO"), in order to operate an Impaired  
16 Driving Enforcement Program ("IDEP") program in the County of Summit, for a grant period  
17 from 10/1/14 through 9/30/15; and

19 WHEREAS, the IDEP grant has provided funding for the past 15 years to the Sheriff's  
20 Office, formerly the grant was called HVEO, for work overtime, in order to conduct impaired  
21 driving enforcement program, public awareness and education in the County of Summit; and

23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
25 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant, and to  
26 appropriate said grant funds, for the period 10/1/14 through 12/31/14, is necessary and in the best  
27 interest of the County of Summit;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

34 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
35 a grant award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for an Impaired Driving Enforcement  
36 Program ("IDEP") overtime grant, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of  
37 \$49,719.55, with no local cash match requirement.
