7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements and extensions to**  
8 **existing agreements with various local employers for participation in the Subsidized**  
9 **Employment Program and reimbursement through the use of Temporary Assistance to**  
10 **Needy Families funds, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in a total amount not to**  
11 **exceed \$150,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and**  
12 **declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-482, which authorized  
15 the County Executive to execute agreements and extensions to existing agreements with various  
16 employers for participation in the Subsidized Employment Program and reimbursement through  
17 the use of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") funds, for the period 10/1/13  
18 through 9/30/14, in a total amount not to exceed \$150,000.00; and

20 WHEREAS, following said approval, the County has entered into new SEP agreements  
21 and extensions to existing agreements with several employers whereby those employers will be  
22 reimbursed using TANF funds for expenses incurred due to newly hired employees; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Executive to execute agreements and extensions to  
25 existing agreements with various local employers for participation in the SEP and reimbursement  
26 through the use of TANF funds, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in a total amount not to  
27 exceed \$150,000.00,

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the  
31 aforementioned agreements and extensions to existing agreements with various employers for  
32 participation in the SEP and reimbursement through the use of TANF funds, for the period  
33 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in a total amount not to exceed \$150,000.00;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
36 State of Ohio, that:

40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute agreements and extensions to  
41 existing agreements with various local employers for participation in the Subsidized  
42 Employment Program and reimbursement through the use of Temporary Assistance to Needy  
43 Families funds, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in a total amount not to exceed  
44 \$150,000.00.

48 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
49 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary  
50 to immediately authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned SEP agreement and  
51 expend TANF funds for reimbursement as timely as possible during the grant period beginning  
52 on 10/1/14.
