7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations in the Operating a Motor Vehicle While**
8 **Intoxicated Task Force Program fund for Fiscal Year 2014 ending 9/30/14, in the amount**
9 **of \$5,053.81, and authorizing additional payments to outside law enforcement agencies, in**
10 **an amount not to exceed \$5,053.81, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-446, which authorized
13 the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award by the Ohio
14 Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice, for a countywide Operating a Motor
15 Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program, in the amount of \$217,881.72 in federal
16 funds, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14, and
17 confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a blanket purchase order for payment to the
18 police departments of Akron, Barberton, Boston Heights, New Franklin, Peninsula, Richfield,
19 Silver Lake, Stow, Medina and Springfield in an aggregate not to exceed \$80,295.54; and

21 WHEREAS, an adjustment in existing appropriations in the OVI Task Force Program
22 fund, in the amount of \$5,053.81, is needed to pay various county law enforcement agencies
23 participating in the Task Force; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that the adjustment of existing appropriations within the OVI Task Force Program fund ending
27 9/30/14, in the amount of \$5,053.81, and the authorization of additional payments to law
28 enforcement agencies for OVI Task Force services, in an amount not to exceed \$5,053.81, is
29 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
