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12 WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds in the amount of
13 \$8,330.00 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") are available
14 to the County of Summit to assist low-to-moderate income persons find housing options; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has
17 a First Home First Loan Program which provides down payment assistance for low-to-moderate
18 income persons and requires loan servicing software; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the appropriation of the aforementioned CDBG funds is necessary and in the best interest of
22 the County of Summit;
