7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**
8 **Graphic Enterprises Office Solutions, Inc., for the renewal of a copier maintenance services**
9 **agreement for 34 copiers, under State Term Pricing, for the period 11/1/14 through**
10 **10/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$28,830.05, for the Executive's Department of Job and**
11 **Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 22, 2014, awarded a
14 purchase order with Graphic Enterprises Office Solutions, Inc., for the renewal of a copier
15 maintenance services agreement for 34 copiers, under State Term Pricing, subject to
16 confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Graphic Enterprises Office
27 Solutions, Inc., for the renewal of a copier maintenance services agreement for 34 copiers, under
28 State Term Pricing, for the period 11/1/14 through 10/31/15, in an amount not to exceed
29 \$28,830.05, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such
30 purchase order.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide for copier maintenance services effective 11/1/14.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section


