7 **A Resolution appropriating revenue funds for the Psycho-Diagnostic Clinic, for the period**  
8 **9/1/14 through 12/31/14, in the amount of \$2,400.00, with no local cash match requirement,**  
9 **for the Court of Common Pleas, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Psycho-Diagnostic Clinic is needed to provide court-ordered evaluations  
12 in criminal cases, and the aforementioned monies will be used to reimburse the Clinic for  
13 expenditures; and

15 WHEREAS, the Psycho-Diagnostic Clinic received revenue funds in the amount of  
16 \$2,400.00 from Portage, Medina, Geauga and Stark counties for performing state-ordered  
17 psychological evaluations; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
20 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the  
21 aforementioned revenue funds in the total amount of \$2,400.00, with no local cash match  
22 requirement;

8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.



16 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


