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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Children’s Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of Adolescent**  
9 **Medicine, to provide physician services for the detention center, for the period 1/1/15**  
10 **through 12/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$215,604.00, for the Court of Common Pleas**  
11 **– Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 19, 2014, awarded a  
14 professional service contract with Children’s Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of  
15 Adolescent Medicine, to provide physician services for the detention center, for the period 1/1/15  
16 through 12/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$215,604.00, subject to confirmation by County  
17 Council; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract is necessary and in the best interest of the  
21 County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Children’s  
29 Hospital Medical Center of Akron, Division of Adolescent Medicine, to provide physician  
30 services for the detention center, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in an amount not to  
31 exceed \$215,604.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to  
32 execute such contract.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide physician services for the Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile Division’s detention center  
39 effective 1/1/15.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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


