7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Richland Engineering Limited for bridge inspection engineering services, in**
9 **an amount not to exceed \$243,504.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 11, 2015, awarded a
12 professional service contract with Richland Engineering Limited for engineering services for
13 fracture critical bridge member inspection of the North Main Street Bridge over the Cuyahoga
14 River (Bridge No. AKR-008-0908) and the Vanderhoof Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas River
15 (Bridge No. FRA-215-0290), in Council Districts 2 and 7, subject to confirmation by County
16 Council; and

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

26 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Richland
27 Engineering Limited for engineering services for fracture critical bridge member inspection of
28 the North Main Street Bridge over the Cuyahoga River (Bridge No. AKR-008-0908) and the
29 Vanderhoof Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas River (Bridge No. FRA-215-0290), in Council
30 Districts 2 and 7, in an amount not to exceed \$243,504.00, is hereby confirmed and the County
31 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 provide for bridge inspection engineering services in 2015.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


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
