7 **An amended Resolution repealing Resolution No. 2015-212 and further authorizing the**
8 **County's Department of Job and Family Services to transfer an amount not to exceed**
9 **\$700,000.00 \$1,200,000.00 in Title XX/TANF and Title XX Base funds, collectively, to**
10 **Summit County Children Services, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
11 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") is
14 the recipient of certain Title XX/TANF funds, which it receives as part of its annual allocation;
15 and

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17 WHEREAS, on September 2, 2014, DJFS received an allocation notice from the State of
18 Ohio, whereby the State set forth the Title XX/TANF allocations for DJFS for the period 10/1/14
19 through 9/30/15; and

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21 WHEREAS, the September 2, 2014 allocation notice indicates that DJFS has been
22 allocated Title XX/TANF funds in the amount of \$2,725,518.00 for the period 10/1/14 through
23 9/30/15; and

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25 WHEREAS, Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") provides protective services
26 for children and emancipating out of foster care services that are eligible expenses for the use of
27 Title XX/TANF funds; and

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29 WHEREAS, in exchange for providing such services, this Council authorized, pursuant
30 to Resolution No. 2015-212, the transfer by DJFS of an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 of
31 Title XX/TANF funds to SCCS to be used for Non-Allocated Children's costs; and

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33 WHEREAS, Title XX Base funds may also be used for protective services for children
34 and emancipating out of foster care services; and

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36 WHEREAS, in another allocation notice dated September 2, 2014, the state notified
37 DJFS that it was allocated \$1,290,858.00 in Title XX Base funds for the period of 10/1/14
38 through 9/30/15; and

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40 WHEREAS, the Executive has recommended that Resolution No. 2015-212 be repealed
41 and that authority be given to transfer an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 \$1,200,000.00 in
42 Title XX/TANF and/or Title XX Base funds, collectively, to SCCS in order to maximize the
43 flexibility of the funds and spend as much of each allocation on services in Summit County; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to repeal Resolution No. 2015-212 and
47 to authorize the transfer of an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 \$1,200,000.00 of Title
48 XX/TANF and Title XX Base funds, collectively, to SCCS, and to authorize the Executive to
49 execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive, through the Department of Job and Family Services, is hereby
10 authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed ~~\$700,000.00~~ \$1,200,000.00 in Title XX/TANF
11 and Title XX Base funds to, collectively, Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") to be used
12 for Non-Allocated Children's Services costs, and the County Executive is further authorized to
13 execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer.

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15 SECTION 2

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17 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
18 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
19 authorize the transfer of said Title XX/TANF and Title XX Base funds, collectively, to SCCS.

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21 SECTION 3

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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27 SECTION 4

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29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
