7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Engineer to advertise for bids for the Yellow Creek**
8 **Road Slope Stabilization Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$950,000.00 for**
9 **the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
12 requires this Council’s authorization for the County Engineer to advertise for bids; and

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14 WHEREAS, due to one lane of Yellow Creek Road, in Bath Township, in Council
15 District 1, being shut down due to erosion and soil movement, the Engineer has determined
16 Yellow Creek Road is in need of a timely slope stabilization project; and

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18 WHEREAS, the project calls for the installation of a one hundred and fifty foot retaining
19 wall, construction of a new storm sewer system, and creek bank stabilization; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Engineer estimate the construction cost to be \$950,000.00 and with all
22 significant expenditures requiring separate Council and/or Board of Control approval; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Engineer to
26 advertise for bids for the Yellow Creek Road Stabilization Project;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for the Yellow Creek Road Stabilization
34 Project, in Bath Township, in Council District 1, with an estimated cost not to exceed
35 \$950,000.00.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will help
41 protect motorists’ safety, halt worsening erosion, and reopen all lanes of traffic on Yellow Creek
42 Road, in Bath Township.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
