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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**
8 **Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two KM 8000T Mounted**
9 **3 ton Hot Boxes for asphalt patching during the winter season, for a total amount not to**
10 **exceed \$56,400.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 23, 2015, awarded a
13 purchase order with Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two KM
14 8000T Mounted 3 ton Hot Boxes for asphalt patching during the winter season, for a total
15 amount not to exceed \$56,400.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
18 the aforementioned purchase order with Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc. is necessary and in the
19 best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Southeastern Equipment Co.,
27 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two KM 8000T Mounted 3 ton Hot Boxes for asphalt
28 patching during the winter season, for a total amount not to exceed \$56,400.00, is hereby
29 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order and
30 any other documents necessary for said purchase.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately
36 provide asphalt patching solutions for the County for the winter season.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
