7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a three-year intergovernmental**  
8 **agreement with the City of Akron for the County's participation in Akron's drug and**  
9 **alcohol testing agreement with SUMMA Health System, d.b.a. SUMMA Center for**  
10 **Corporate Health, for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, for the Executive's Department**  
11 **of Human Resources, and declaring an emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, the City of Akron ("Akron") entered into an agreement with SUMMA  
14 Health System, d.b.a. SUMMA Center for Corporate Health, an Ohio non-profit corporation  
15 ("SUMMA"), for the provision of certain professional services to provide the collection, testing  
16 and medical review services for drug and alcohol testing; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, Akron has offered the County the opportunity to fully participate in Akron's  
19 drug and alcohol testing agreement with SUMMA, for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, which  
20 will reduce costs and increase the efficiency of operations for both Akron and the County; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, in order for the County to participate in Akron's drug and alcohol testing  
23 services, it is necessary for the City and County to execute an intergovernmental agreement  
24 setting forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties and binding the County to the terms and  
25 conditions of Akron's agreement with SUMMA; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(10) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
28 authorizes the County to participate in "[c]ontracts for the acquisition of utilities, equipment,  
29 materials, supplies or services upon the same financial terms as a contract entered into by another  
30 political subdivision of the State of Ohio provided that the contract entered into by the other  
31 political subdivision was awarded pursuant to a request for proposals or a competitive selection  
32 procedure of that political subdivision;" and

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34 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2014-189, the County entered into such a three-  
35 year intergovernmental agreement with Akron for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/16; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
38 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
39 Executive to execute a three-year intergovernmental agreement with Akron for the County's  
40 participation in Akron's drug and alcohol testing agreement with SUMMA for the period 1/1/17  
41 through 12/31/19;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
44 of Ohio, that:

46 SECTION 1

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48 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement  
49 with the City of Akron ("Akron") for the County's participation in Akron's drug and alcohol  
50 agreement with SUMMA Health System, d.b.a. SUMMA Center for Corporate Health  
51 ("SUMMA"), for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/19. The Executive is hereby authorized to  
52 execute the intergovernmental agreement with Akron in a form substantially similar to the one

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6 attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A. The Executive is hereby authorized to pay the drug and  
7 alcohol testing fees set forth in Akron's agreement with SUMMA for testing of County  
8 employees.

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10 SECTION 2

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12 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
13 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
14 authorize the Executive to execute a three-year intergovernmental agreement with Akron for the  
15 County's participation in Akron's agreement with SUMMA for drug and alcohol testing and  
16 realize immediate savings and efficiency.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
