8 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
9 **accept the award of grant stipend funds from the Treatment Research Institute, in the**  
10 **approximate amount of \$10,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, in exchange for**  
11 **the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division's entry of data in the Tri-Court Evaluation**  
12 **Program, and appropriating these grant stipend funds, which may be used for recovery**  
13 **support and treatment services, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and**  
14 **declaring an emergency.**

16 WHEREAS, the Treatment Research Institute is evaluating the Ohio Addiction  
17 Treatment Program for the State of Ohio Mental Health & Addiction Services Board using data  
18 entered by participating agencies in the Tri-Court Evaluation Program ("TRI-CEP"); and

19  
20 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division is a participating agency that  
21 is entering data into TRI-CEP; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, in exchange for its entry of data into TRI-CEP, the Juvenile Division will  
24 receive an award of grant stipend funds from the Treatment Research Institute, which may be  
25 used for recovery support and treatment services through the Juvenile Division's Drug Court  
26 Program; and

28 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Division will receive approximately \$10,000.00 in grant  
29 stipend funds, with no local cash match requirement; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
33 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant  
34 stipend funds from the Treatment Research Institute and to appropriate these grant stipend funds;

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36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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41 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
42 grant stipend funds from the Treatment Research Institute, in the approximate amount of  
43 \$10,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, in exchange for the Court of Common Pleas-  
44 Juvenile Division's entry of data in the Tri-Court Evaluation Program (TRI-CEP), which is being  
45 used the Treatment Research Institute in evaluating the Ohio Addiction Treatment Program for  
46 the State of Ohio Mental Health & Addiction Services Board.

14 appropriations and establish Fund 21981.

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18 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
19 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
20 authorize the acceptance of the grant stipend funds awarded by the Treatment Research Center so  
21 that said funds may be immediately expended by the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division  
22 for recovery support and treatment services through its Drug Court Program to help Summit  
23 County families.

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27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
37 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
