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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award of a 2016-2017 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Training**
9 **Grant from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for the period of 10/1/16 through**
10 **9/30/18, in the amount of \$14,400.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement, in the**
11 **amount of \$3,600.00, and appropriating funds, for the Executive's Department of Law,**
12 **Insurance and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management**
13 **Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") has awarded a Fiscal
16 Year 2016-2017 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness ("HMEP") Training Grant to the
17 Summit County Emergency Management Agency for the period of 10/1/16 through 9/30/18, in
18 the amount of \$14,400.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement, in the amount of \$3,600.00,
19 which the Local Emergency Planning Committee will provide from its training budget; and

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21 WHEREAS, this funding will support three safety and response training sessions for first
22 responders in Summit County; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
26 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned HMEP Training
27 Grant from the OEMA and to appropriate these grant funds and the local cash match
28 requirement;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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35 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
36 the award of a Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness ("HMEP")
37 Training Grant from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA"), for the period of
38 10/1/16 through 9/30/18, in the amount of \$14,400.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement,
39 in the amount of \$3,600.00.


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17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take

27 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
