A Resolution amending Resolution No. 2014-031 to increase the amount of the Permanent Change Fund to \$1,350.00 for the clerks' cash drawers at the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development-Building Standards, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development-Division of Building Standards, and declaring an emergency.		
WHEREAS, the clerks of the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development-Division of Building Standards ("Building Standards") are responsible for accepting and processing building permit and plans review applications; and		
WHEREAS, as part of the performance of their jobs, the Building Standards clerks accept payments for associated fees, and need cash on hand to make change for cash payments from time to time; and		
WHEREAS, the Department of Internal Audit advised that the Building Standards clerks should each have separate cash drawers, rather than the previous practice of sharing one drawer amongst all of the clerks; and		
WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-031, which established a Building Standards Permanent Change Fund in the amount of \$1,050.00, in order to provide \$150.00 in cash for each of the cash drawers that will be maintained by Building Standards; and		
WHEREAS, two additional clerks have been hired at Building Standards, requiring two additional cash drawers, which makes it necessary to amend Resolution No. 2014-031 to increase the amount of the Permanent Change Fund by \$300.00 to \$1,350.00; and		
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of this Council to amend Resolution No. 2014-031 to increase the amount of the Permanent Change Fund to \$1,350.00;		
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:		
SECTION 1		
Section 1 of Resolution No. 2014-031 is her	reby amended to increase by \$300.00, for a	

total amount of \$1,350.00, the Permanent Change Fund for use by clerks at the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development-Building Standards, for making change out of their cash drawers in the process of accepting fees associated with the

acceptance and processing of building permits and plans review applications.

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SECTION 2		
The County Fiscal Officer shall issue a warrant payable to the order of the Assistant Director of Community and Economic Development that oversees Building Standards. Such		
Assistant Director shall endorse and cash the warrant and deposit such money into the cash drawers to be used by the Building Standards clerks.		
SECTION 3		
The Building Standards Permanent Change Fund shall remain fixed at \$1,350.00 unless modified by further action of this Council.		
SECTION 4		
This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to immediately increase the Permanent Change Fund made necessary by the hiring of two additional clerks at Building Standards.		
SECTION 5		
Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.		
SECTION 6		
It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
