7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **PVS Technologies, Inc. for 300,000 dry pounds of ferric chloride solution, in an amount not**
9 **to exceed \$70,200.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and**
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-452, which authorized
13 the County Executive to advertise for bids for 300,000 dry pounds of ferric chloride solution in
14 an estimated amount not to exceed \$75,000.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held December 6, 2017, awarded a
17 purchase contract with PVS Technologies, Inc. for 300,000 dry pounds of ferric chloride
18 solution, in an amount not to exceed \$70,200.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the aforementioned purchase contract with PVS Technologies, Inc. is necessary and in the
22 best interest of the County of Summit;

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24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with PVS Technologies, Inc.
30 for 300,000 dry pounds of ferric chloride solution, in an amount not to exceed \$70,200.00, is
31 hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase
32 contract.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide necessary ferric chloride solution at the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services' Waste
39 Water Treatment Plants.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
