141.01 CONTINUATION; COMPOSITION AND VACANCIES.

- (a) The County Planning Commission, established pursuant to Ohio R.C. 713.22, shall continue to exercise the powers and duties established by general law.
- The Planning Commission shall consist of nine (9) citizens of the County, and one-two District Representatives and one At-Large Representative from Summit County Council. The members of the Commission shall continue in their positions for their respective terms. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment of the Executive pursuant to Section 2.03 (2) of the County Charter.
- (c) The terms for the District Representatives and the At-Large Representative from Summit County Council shall run concurrently with the balance of the Representatives unexpired term. All other members shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years with the current members if the Commission continuing in their positions for the balance of their current terms. commence immediately and shall expire on December 31, 2004 and December 31, 2002 respectively. All appointments for successor District Representatives and At-Large Representatives shall be for a period of four years.
