7 **A Resolution approving a collective bargaining agreement between the Summit County**
8 **Juvenile Court and Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with the International Brotherhood of**
9 **Teamsters, for the period 11/6/17 through 3/31/20, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been negotiated and agreed to in
13 principal between the Summit County Juvenile Court and Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with
14 the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, for the period 11/6/17 through 3/31/20; and

15
16 WHEREAS, the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement was not negotiated by
17 the County Executive's Office because the Juvenile Court is outside the scope of authority of
18 County Executive to negotiate collective bargaining agreements as such authority is set forth in
19 the Summit County Charter; and

20
21 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court has negotiated certain terms of the agreement that are not
22 consistent with the terms of the collective bargaining agreements concerning employees of the
23 County's Charter offices that have previously been negotiated by the County Executive; and

25 WHEREAS, although the aforementioned agreement is outside the scope of the County
26 Executive's authority to negotiate collective bargaining agreements conferred by the Summit
27 County Charter, Section 4117.10 of the Ohio Revised Code vests with this Council, as the
28 legislative authority that appropriates funds for the Juvenile Court's operation, the express
29 authority to approve or reject the aforementioned agreement; and

31 WHEREAS, the authority conferred under Section 4117.10 to approve or reject the
32 aforementioned agreement is the authority to approve or reject the agreement as a whole, and the
33 legislative authority does not have authority to reject certain provisions of the agreement while
34 approving others; and

36 WHEREAS, while this Council does not favorably view the terms of the aforementioned
37 agreement that differ from the terms of the collective bargaining agreements concerning
38 employees of the County's Charter offices, it nonetheless has determined that approving the
39 agreement as a whole is in the best interest of the County compared to rejecting the agreement as
40 a whole.

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
43 of Ohio, that:

47 This Council hereby approves the collective bargaining agreement between the Summit
48 County Juvenile Court and Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with the International Brotherhood

19 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


