7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**
8 **Management-Division of Public Safety to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed**
9 **\$25,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions to be**
10 **held in 2018, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-**
11 **Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk
14 Management-Division of Public Safety conducts various training and planning sessions,
15 including domestic preparedness steering committee workshops and law enforcement, fire,
16 dispatch and emergency medical services personnel training, for the County of Summit; and

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18 WHEREAS, such training sessions are attended by county employees, public safety
19 personnel, outside organizations and elected officials; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management
22 wishes to pay hospitality expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00, for 2018 related to
23 the aforementioned training and planning sessions, all of which are paid for through various
24 grant funds; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Ohio issued Opinion No.
27 82-006, which authorizes the expenditure of funds by a local political subdivision for its
28 employees as long as those expenditures are necessary to further a public purpose and if the
29 political subdivision's determination to make such expenditures is not manifestly arbitrary or
30 unreasonable; and

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32 WHEREAS, Section 177.24 (b) and (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of
33 Summit require the approval of County Council for hospitality expenditures exceeding \$2,000.00
34 per year and for hospitality expenditures for purposes other than employee training, meetings and
35 organization strategic planning meetings; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
38 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive's
39 Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management expenditures, in an amount not to exceed
40 \$25,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2018 and
41 that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose;

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43 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division
7 of Public Safety is hereby authorized to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed
8 \$25,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing planning and training sessions to be held
9 in 2018. This Council hereby finds and determines that such expenses are for a valid public
10 purpose.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
15 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately
16 authorizing the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety
17 to make expenditures for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions to
18 be held in 2018.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 SECTION 4

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28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
29 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
30 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
32 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
