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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute professional service contracts**
8 **with certain providers, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, for behavioral**
9 **health and juvenile justice services, for the period 7/1/18 through 6/30/19, in a total amount**
10 **not to exceed \$249,500.00, for the Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile Division, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County Executive desires to execute professional service contracts with
14 certain providers for behavioral health and juvenile justice services, for the period 7/1/18 through
15 6/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$249,500.00, subject to confirmation by County Council as
16 set forth by Exhibit A, attached hereto, and incorporated therein by reference; and

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18 WHEREAS, the authorization of the County Executive to execute the aforementioned
19 contracts is subject to the approval of the Board of Control, prior to, or subsequent to, the
20 adoption of this Resolution; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that the aforementioned professional service contracts with certain providers are necessary and in
24 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
27 of Ohio, that:

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29 SECTION 1

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31 The County Executive is hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the Board of
32 Control, to execute professional service contracts with certain providers, for behavioral health
33 and juvenile justice services, for the period 7/1/18 through 6/30/19, in a total amount not to
34 exceed \$249,500.00 as set forth by Exhibit A, attached hereto, and incorporated therein by
35 reference.

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
41 provide for behavioral health and justice services to the Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile
42 Division effective 7/1/18.

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
