7 **An Ordinance amending certain sections of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit in order to place employee benefits duties and responsibilities under the**
9 **Executive's Department of Human Resources and to clarify other sections, for the**
10 **Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to place employee benefits duties and
13 responsibilities, currently under the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk
14 Management, under the Executive's Department of Human Resources; and

15
16 WHEREAS, consequently, the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management will
17 be known as the Department of Law and Risk Management; and

18
19 WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend certain sections of the Codified Ordinances of the
20 County of Summit in order to implement the aforementioned changes; and

21
22 WHEREAS, it is further necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances in order to clarify
23 other sections; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend certain sections of
27 the Codified Ordinances in order to place employee benefits duties and responsibilities under the
28 Executive's Department of Human Resources and to clarify other sections; and

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
31 State of Ohio, that:

33 SECTION 2

35 The Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit are hereby amended as set forth in
36 Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

38 SECTION 2

40 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
41 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to amend certain
42 sections of the Codified Ordinances in order to place employee benefits duties and
43 responsibilities under the Executive's Department of Human Resources and to clarify other
44 sections so that the Department of Human Resources may immediately begin to exercise said
45 duties and responsibilities.

49 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
50 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
51 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
