**A Motion of Council suspending Council Rule 8.06 and extending time on Resolution 2017-434 through October 1, 2018.**

**MOTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT**

Whereas, Section 3.04 of the Charter of the County of Summit provides for the County Council to determine its own rules and order of business; and

Whereas, Resolution 2017-434 was introduced October 16, 2017 and would approve the vacation of a portion of Everett Road located in Bath, Richfield, and Boston Township and a portion of Oak Hill Road located in Boston Township, pursuant to Chapter 5553 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 125.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

Whereas, Section 8.06 of the Rules of the Council of the County of Summit provides that legislation not adopted by Council within four (4) calendar months of the date of introduction shall expire, unless the rule is suspended by the affirmative vote of at least six (6) Members of Council; and

Whereas, Council previously adopted Motion M-006-2018 extending time on Resolution 2017-434 through June 25, 2018; and

Whereas, it is the wish of the Chair of the Planning and Economic Development Committee to continue to extend time on Resolution 2017-434 through October 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MOVED AND APPROVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, that:

Section 1: Section 8.06 of the Rules of the Council of the County of Summit is hereby suspended and time on Resolution 2017-434 is extended through October 1, 2018.
