A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire two external people into full-time non-bargaining unclassified Attorney I positions, at an hourly salary of \$20.11/hour each, or, in lieu of the Attorney I position, two part-time non-bargaining unclassified Student Helper positions, at an hourly salary of \$10.14/hour, each, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employee; and

WHEREAS, due to separations through resignation and retirement, as well as the addition of two new judges for the Court of Common Pleas, General Division, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of her office to be permitted to hire two full-time Attorney I positions, both of which are entry-level positions within the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has met its 2010 targeted budget and will make the requested hires within the targeted budget; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of hiring either two full-time Attorney I positions, the Prosecutor could hire up to two part-time Student Helper positions, which would enable the Prosecutor to employ current law school students who may be certified to perform prosecutions on behalf of the County; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Prosecutor to hire either part-time Student Helper positions, if students are available and/or qualified to fill those positions, or the authority to hire two full-time Attorney I positions will be necessary; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire either two external people into full-time non-bargaining unclassified Attorney I positions, at an hourly salary of \$20.11/hour, each, or, in lieu of the Attorney I position, up to two part-time non-bargaining unclassified Student Helper positions, at an hourly salary of \$10.14/hour, each;
