A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a federal grant in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), with no local cash match requirement, for the period 3/11/09 through 3/10/12, and appropriating these funds for expenditures through 12/31/09, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice Office COPS has awarded a federal grant to the County of Summit Sheriff for the purpose of purchasing a bomb robot; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff's Bomb Squad is the sole agency responsible for bomb disposal incidents for all federal, state and local law enforcement agencies in a nine-county area of northeast and central Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, and to appropriate the funds from said award;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned award from the U.S. Department of Justice Office in the amount of \$100,000.00, with no local cash match requirement.

SECTION 2

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

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SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately accepting and appropriating the USDOJ 2009 grant award allocation.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 6


