A Resolution appropriating Title IV-E federal reimbursement funds received from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, in the amount of \$210,696.27, through 12/31/09, for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, in 2006, Juvenile Court became qualified to receive Title IV-E reimbursement for placement costs, paid by other than federal dollars, for eligible youths; and

WHEREAS, these funds are needed to supplement Fiscal Year 2009 costs for Juvenile Court's Family Resource Center and Child Advocate Team; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned appropriation is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Title IV-E Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

The County Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within appropriations.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately provide for the necessary appropriations for the Title IV-E funds.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
