A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 for delinquent care and custody grant services for assessment of disproportionate minority contact data and the decision points within the Juvenile Justice System, with Dr. RaJade Berry James, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, for a cumulative total increase of \$15,000.00 (100% cumulative increase), for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 16, 2009, awarded a change order provide the aforementioned services, subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 for delinquent care and custody grant services for assessment of disproportionate minority contact data and the decision points within the Juvenile Justice System, with Dr. RaJade Berry James, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00, for a cumulative total increase of \$15,000.00 (100% cumulative increase), is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide the aforementioned services.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
