A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a 2009-2010 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant award, in the amount of \$34,435.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$11,478.33, for a total of \$45,913.33, and a 2009-2010 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant award of \$3,129.00, with no local cash match requirement, both from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the period 10/01/09 through 9/30/10 and appropriating the VOCA program funds in the amount of \$11,600.00 through 12/31/09, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2009-2010 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant award, in the amount of \$34,435.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$11,478.33, for a total of \$45,913.33, to covers salaries and benefits for a volunteer coordinator to manage the services to child abuse victims that are provided through Court Appointed Special Advocate ("CASA") volunteer child advocates and court child advocates; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2009-2010 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant award of \$3,129.00, with no local cash match requirement, both from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the period 10/01/09 through 9/30/10; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court has provided for the local cash match requirement for the VOCA grant in its General Fund budget; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate VOCA grant funds in the amount of \$11,600.00 through 12/31/09;

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant awards and to appropriate VOCA grant funds in the amount of \$11,600.00 through 12/31/09;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a 2009-2010 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant award, in the amount of \$34,435.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$11,478.33, for a total of \$45,913.33, and a 2009-2010 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant award of \$3,129.00, with no local cash match requirement, both from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the period 10/01/09 through 9/30/10.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6


It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
