A Resolution certifying deferred sewer tap-in fees to the County Fiscal Officer, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(c) of Title V of the Codified Ordinances provides for the certification of sewer tap-in fees under the extended payment program administered by the County Executive's Department of Environmental Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(c) of Title V of the Codified Ordinances provides that these charges are to be certified to the County Fiscal Officer and placed on the property tax duplicate for collection; and

WHEREAS, This Council has determined by reviewing all the pertinent information that certifying the aforementioned charges to the Fiscal Officer is necessary and in the best interests of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1
