A Resolution appropriating \$130,247.54, for the Reentry Court Enhancement Grant, and appropriating \$93,954.21 for the Probation Risk/Needs Assessment Grant, through 12/31/2009, from the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services with U.S. Department of Justice, Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") funds, made available through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("ARRA") of 2009 for a total of \$224,201.81 which includes a 25% local match, for a grant period ending 12/31/10, for the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-088, the County Executive is authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept funds made available by the ARRA of 2009, signed into Law by President Obama on 2/27/2009, including executing and submitting a substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plan, but said funds must be appropriated prior to being spent; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas has received ARRA funding made available from the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice and with the 25% local match requirement to come from moving an employee from the General Fund into the Grant Fund, for a Reentry Court Enhancement program which will increase the number of courtrooms used for reentry; and

WHEREAS; the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas has received ARRA funding made available from the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice and with the 25% local match requirement to come from the Adult Probation Services Fees Fund, for an Adult Probation Risk/Needs Assessment program which will provide appropriate detail for customized case management plans; and

WHEREAS; both the Reentry Court Enhancement program and the Adult Probation Risk/Needs Assessment program can help to reduce recidivism rates in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned funds in the amount of \$224,201.81 received from the ARRA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 5


