A Resolution appropriating \$78,000.00, for the Child Advocate Team (“CAT”), through 12/31/09 in U.S. Department of Justice JAG funds, from the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services, made available through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (“ARRA”), in the total project amount of \$261,356.00, which includes a 25% match, for the grant period ending 12/31/10, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-088, the County Executive is authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept funds made available by the ARRA, signed into law by President Obama on 2/27/09, including executing and submitting a substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plan, but said funds must be appropriated prior to being spent; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit’s Juvenile Court’s CAT program’s Title XX Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (“TANF”) funding ended 7/31/09; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit’s Juvenile Court has received Recovery Act funding made available from the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice for the CAT program; and

WHEREAS, the Court’s CAT program provides intensive case management services to children in both temporary and permanent Children Services custody to help ensure that the best interests of dependent, neglected or abused children are protected and presented at hearings to the Court; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned funds in the amount of \$78,000.00 received from the Recovery Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately provide for the necessary ARRA grant appropriations for the Juvenile Court's CAT program.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
