An amended Resolution appropriating U. S. Department of Justice JAG funds available though the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, of ~~\$38,088.45~~, \$38,128.45 from the City of Akron through 12/31/2009, for the Sheriff's Department and declaring an emergency

WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("Recovery Act") (Public Law 111-5) was signed into Law by President Obama on 2/27/2009, making additional fund available to projects within Summit County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-088, the County Executive is authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept these additional Funds, but said funds must be appropriated prior to being spent; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Akron was awarded a Recovery Act JAG grant which included funding for training and equipment for the County of Summit Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned funds in the amount of ~~\$38,088.45~~ \$38,128.45 received from the Recovery Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Recovery Act JAG Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:


SECTION 5
