A Resolution appropriating Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") National Emergency Grant OH-19 Automotive, Dual Enrollment American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds for WIA Area 20, of \$140,824.00 from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS"), through December 31, 2009, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the National Emergency Grant ("NEG") OH-19 Automotive, Dual Enrollment American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) provides WIA Area 20, being Summit and Medina Counties, with a WIA federal stimulus and emergency allocations for allowable expenditures made between April 1, 2009 and March 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Summit County is the fiscal agent for Local Area 20 departments of job and family services, which includes Summit and Medina Counties, and is required by such to distribute State Pass-Through WIA funds as prescribed, and receives administrative funding for these services; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2009-088 authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept said award, which he has done and will continue to do; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate said funds in the amount of \$140,824.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated for the Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") National Emergency Grant OH-19 Automotive, Dual Enrollment American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 as follows:

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately appropriating the WIA Stimulus Allocations award.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
