A Resolution appropriating \$25,000.00 in grant funds received from the U.S. Marshall's Office and \$14,400.00 in grant funds received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, for a total amount of \$39,400.00 for a Fugitive Safe Surrender ("FSS") Program to be conducted July 29, 2009 through August 1, 2009, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a Fugitive Safe Surrender Task Force comprised of the Summit County Sheriff's Office, the Akron Police Department and other Summit County Departments, and funded by the U.S. Marshall and the Ohio Attorney General, will offer favorable consideration from prosecutors and courts for individuals who accept responsibility for their actions and voluntarily surrender to authorities at set locations; and

WHEREAS, this community partnership program was initiated in Cleveland in August of 2005 and to date, in fourteen cities across the nation, has secured the voluntary and peaceful surrender of nearly 20,000 individuals since that initial event; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marshall's Office has provided grant funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 and the Ohio Attorney General's Office has provided \$14,400.00 in grant funds, for a total amount of \$39,400.00, to a FSS Program to be conducted July 29, 2009 through August 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned funds in the amount of \$39,400.00 for the FSS Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
