A Resolution appropriating \$44,420.00 received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office for a Training Rotary fund, through 12/31/2009, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 109.803 of the Ohio Revised Code sets continuing professional training requirements for peace officers, and Section 109.802 establishes the law enforcement assistance fund for the reimbursement of continuing professional training costs; and

WHEREAS, a payment has issued from the State of Ohio Attorney General in the amount of \$56,840.00 for the Sheriff's Office as reimbursement for training costs; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests \$44,420.00 in contract and equipment expense related to continuing professional training ("CPT"); and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned funds in the amount of \$44,420.00 received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
