A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of an amendment to a professional service contract with Safety First, Inc. to provide services in addition to Northeast Central Regional Medical Response System Coordinator services, for an additional not to exceed amount of \$19,500.00 (for an increase of 43.33%), for a total not to exceed contract amount of ~~\$64,500.00~~^{\$65,000.00}, for the Executive's Division of Public Safety—Emergency Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2008-012, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Safety First, Inc. to provide Northeast Central Regional Medical Response System Coordinator services, in an amount not to exceed \$45,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive executed the aforementioned contract; and

WHEREAS, Safety First, Inc. has agreed to provide the following additional services:

1. Develop topics, identify contractor and manage logistics for conducting a regional seminar;
2. Assist counties within region with implementing resource inventory management software;
3. Assist counties within region to develop radio communication procedures;
4. Acquire a subscription for web-based meeting software and a conference call line for use by regional partners; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the contract is necessary; and

WHEREAS, at its May 27, 2009 meeting, the Board of Control awarded an amendment to the contract for the additional services, for an additional not to exceed amount of \$19,500.00 (for an increase of 43.33%), for a total not to exceed contract amount of ~~\$64,500.00~~^{\$65,000.00}; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all pertinent information, this Council has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the Board of Control of the aforementioned amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of an amendment to a professional service contract with Safety First, Inc. to provide services in addition to Northeast Central Regional Medical Response System Coordinator services, for an additional not to exceed amount of \$19,500.00 (for an increase of 43.33%), for a total not to exceed contract amount of ~~\$64,500.00~~^{\$65,000.00}, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said amendment. A copy of the proposed additional scope of services is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately confirm the award of an amendment to the professional service contract with Safety First, Inc. for the provision of additional services.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and shall be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Scope of Work for Contract Addendum for NECO Region 5 RMRS Coordination

1. Develop topics for, identify contractor and manage logistics for conducting a regional seminar on use of security forces for major events, biological emergencies and mass dispensing activities. Audience will include public health, hospitals, emergency management and public safety officials.
2. Assist county emergency management and public safety agencies in the NECO Region 5 implement the EPRI software tool to assist with resource inventory management.
3. Assist counties in NECO Region 5 develop tactical interoperability standard operating procedures (SOP) with adjacent counties within the region.
4. Acquire a subscription for Go-to-Webinar and Survey Monkey for use by RMRS partners within NECO Region 5 and implement their use.
5. Acquire a subscription for a conference call line for use by RMRS partners and implement its use.
