**A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a fiscal year 2008 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program ("SCAAP") grant from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Affairs, in the amount of \$41,734.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating grant funds for the fiscal year ending 12/31/09, for the Executive's Division of Public Safety–Justice Affairs, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, through the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program ("SCAAP") passed by Congress, the Office of Justice Affairs in the United States Department of Justice annually grants funding to the State of Ohio for correctional purposes related to the incarceration of undocumented criminal aliens; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has been awarded an SCAAP grant in the amount of \$41,734.00, with no local cash match requirement, which has no time limit for expenditures and which may be used for certain construction, certain training and/or education for offenders, and/or specialized training for corrections officers; and

WHEREAS, the County has had discussions with SCAAP coordinator for approved uses for the funding which includes contracts for an upgrade to County Jail's Sentinel system to include the "take me home" database for the County Prosecutor's Office, and training for the County Sheriff's officers at a national conference; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned SCAAP grant and to appropriate grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a fiscal year 2008 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program ("SCAAP") grant from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Affairs, in the amount of \$41,734.00, with no local match requirement, and appropriating these funds for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009.


SECTION 6
