**A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract with the Victim Assistance Program, for a grant in the amount of \$75,000.00 for the year 2009, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Amended Resolution No. 2008-485, which, as part of the 2009 General Fund Budget, appropriated funds in the amount of \$75,000.00 for a grant to the Victim Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County of Summit and the Victim Assistance Program to execute a contract for the aforementioned grant; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract with the Victim Assistance Program for the aforementioned grant is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Victim Assistance Program for a grant in the amount of \$75,000.00 for the year 2009. Said grant will be paid out of account number 10003-8017-65111.

#### SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that the County wishes to immediately provide support through a grant to the Victim Assistance Program.

#### SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


#### SECTION 4


