**A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of State Fiscal Year 2009 Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") educational and employment services contract change orders and amendments for summer youth employment services with various providers per attached Exhibit A, for the period 7/1/08 to 9/30/09, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,324,391.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 6, 2009, awarded the subject contract change orders and amendments with various providers per attached Exhibit A, subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the change orders and amendments are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of State Fiscal Year 2009 WIA educational and employment services contract change orders and amendments with various providers per attached Exhibit A, for the period 7/1/08 to 9/30/09, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,324,391.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change orders and amendments.

#### SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide summer youth employment services.

#### SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

#### SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
