**A Resolution extending the deadline for County appointing authorities, offices, agencies, boards and commissions to execute a Memorandum of Understanding to participate in the County of Summit Voluntary Separation Plan from April 29, 2009 to May 8, 2009, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2009, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2009-112, whereby the County of Summit Voluntary Separation Plan ("the Plan") was authorized and approved, the County Executive was authorized to administer the plan and the plan was made available to all County appointing authorities, offices, agencies, boards and commissions ("Office/Offices"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Plan, for employees of an Office to participate in the Plan, the Office must agree to a Memorandum of Understanding with the County Executive whereby the Office agrees to comply with the savings/cost reduction plan that makes the Plan beneficial to the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Plan, the deadline for Offices to sign the Memorandum of Understanding is April 30, 2009 at 4:00pm; and

WHEREAS, several offices have already either signed the necessary Memorandum of Understanding or expressed their intent to do so, however, some offices, in particular the Board of Elections, may not be able to execute the Memorandum of Understanding prior to the deadline for various reasons; and

WHEREAS, in order to maximize the number of employees that are able to participate in the Plan, it is in the best interest of the County to extend the deadline for Offices to sign the Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to extend the deadline for offices to sign the Memorandum of Understanding to participate in the Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The deadline for Offices to sign a memorandum of Understanding to participate in the County of Summit Voluntary Separation Plan, as authorized by Resolution No. 2009-112 is hereby extended to Friday, May 8, 2009 at 4:00pm.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately extend the deadline for Offices to participate in the Plan prior to the expiration of the initial deadline.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
