A Resolution appropriating additional Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") Incumbent Worker Training ("IWT") Program funds in the amount of \$95,993.00 for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, as a result of the County receiving additional funds as Fiscal Agent for WIA Local Area 20 from the State, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Substitute House Bill 372, the State of Ohio implemented an Incumbent Worker Training ("IWT") program, financed by federal Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") funds, to be administered through a joint partnership between the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, the Ohio Department of Development and the local workforce investment areas; and

WHEREAS, Summit County falls under the purview of WIA Local Area 20, along with Medina County, with the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services acting as the fiscal agent for WIA Local Area 20; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the WIA Incumbent Worker Training program, the State of Ohio has selected certain employers in both Summit and Medina County to receive the WIA Incumbent Worker Training funds, which will pass through the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services as the WIA Local Area 20 fiscal agent; and

WHEREAS, the WIA Incumbent Worker Training funds are distributed to the State of Ohio selected employers by the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services pursuant to a standard State-developed agreement that must be executed by the County Executive for employers located in Summit County and the Medina County Commissioners for employers located in Medina County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2008-365, 2008-511 and 2009-056, this Council authorized the Executive to execute several WIA Incumbent Worker Training agreements and appropriated WIA Incumbent Worker Training funds received by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services has received notification from the State of Ohio of awards of \$64,493.00 for two additional IWT vendors and additional administrative costs associated with Summit County's administration of the WIA Incumbent Worker Training program; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services also received notification from the State of Ohio of additional IWT training awards for Medina County in the amount of \$31,500.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate said additional WIA Incumbent Worker Training funds for use in said program.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009:

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately appropriate said fund so that they may be spent as soon as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5


