**A Resolution appropriating the award of \$10,000.00 in a Statewide Search & Rescue Capability grant, from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for the period 1/1/09 through 6/30/09, with no local cash match requirement, for the Executive's Department of Public Safety and Criminal Justice Affairs Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Public Safety – Emergency Management Agency has awarded the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency the amount of \$10,000.00 in State grant funds, with no local cash match requirement, to provide materials which will support the State's mission to create a stronger search and rescue capability statewide; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2008-433 accepted the Statewide Search & Rescue Capability grant award of \$10,000 with no local cash match requirement, for the period 7/1/08 through 6/30/09; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

The Statewide Search & Rescue Capability grant funds are hereby appropriated as follows:


SECTION 5
