A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a 2003 Project Safe Neighborhood subgrant award of \$45,650.98, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 3/10/09 to 5/31/09, from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS"), for the Operation Spring Cleaning Project, and appropriating these grant funds, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff's Office has received a U.S. Department of Justice-Bureau of Justice Assistance grant funding award, with no matching funds requirement, from the Ohio Department of Public Safety OCJS, to support efforts in fugitive apprehension, patrol saturation, nuisance control, curfew enforcement and other duties; and

WHEREAS, the funds are from a 2003-PS-PSN-367 federal grant program and only available through May 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office will work in partnership with the Akron Police Department and the U.S. Marshals on this limit time grant funding; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant and the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept an Operation Spring Cleaning grant award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, for the period 3/10/2009 to 5/31/2009.

SECTION 2

The 2003 Project Safe Neighborhood grant funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
